## Show Rules

- Weigh-ins: 8:00 AM until 10:00AM for goats, 8:00 AM until 11:00 AM for lambs, 8:00 AM until 1:00 PM for Hogs.
- Show Schedule: Goats start at 11:00 am, followed immediately by lambs, and then hogs.
- Class Order: Type Classes followed by Showmanship. (Seniors 16-21, Intermediate 12-15, Juniors 8-11 as of age on Jan. 1<sup>st</sup> of current year.)

### General Rules:

1. Show is open to all youth between the ages of eight and twenty-one as of January 1, 2008 from any state.
2. There is no limit on the number of animals youth can enter/exhibit.
3. Entries will be accepted until the close of the scales.
4. No refunds for no-shows.
5. There are no weight limits.
6. Classes will be divided as evenly as possible.
7. Lambs and goats will be divided into nine weight classes with three classes per division. Pigs will be at the discretion of the show committee.
8. No bedding will be provided. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning out pens!
9. Animals showing signs of contagious, or infectious disease, or external parasites will not be allowed to show.
10. Exhibitors must have all necessary health papers. All health papers must be checked before unloading.
11. Pennsylvania animals to be exhibited must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian. The certificate must be issued within 90 days of the show.
12. Out of state animals to be exhibited must be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection signed by an accredited veterinarian. The certificate must be issued within 30 days of the show.
13. Use only grooming products that are approved for use on meat producing animals when fitting animals for show.

### Goat Rules:

1. Show is open to does and wethers.
2. Goats must have a full set of kid's teeth.
3. All doe kids must bear an official USDA/APHIS eartag or tattoo to be exhibited.
4. All goats must be identified by either an eartag or tattoo.

### Lamb Rules:

1. Show is open to ewe lambs and wethers.
2. Lambs must have a full set of lamb's teeth.
3. All ewe lambs must bear an official USDA/APHIS eartag to be exhibited.
4. All lambs must be identified by either an eartag or tattoo.

### Hog Rules and Health Requirements:

1. Show is open to gilts and barrows.
2. All hogs must meet health requirements set by PA Dept of Agriculture.
3. All hogs must be identified by an eartag, ear notch or tattoo.

### Pedigreed Hog Classes

1. Pigs must have a valid pedigree from national breed registry. Animals without will show as crossbred.
2. Barrows and gilts will show together as prospect hogs.
3. Classes will be offered for all pedigreed purebred swine, however classes with less than five entries will be combined.
