

Health Regulations

1. Each animal must be accompanied by **TWO COPIES** of an official interstate health certificate issued by a licensed, accredited veterinarian. Certificates must show name and address of consignor; consigned to the Summer Type Conference, Louisville, Ky.; individual identification of the animal; and health status of animal including the dates of required tests and vaccinations. **Crossbred animals must be identified by a federally recognized numbered ear tag.**

2. All certificates must be issued after June 8, 2009, with the following information:

A. **Brucellosis:** All animals must originate from a Brucellosis Class "Free" state or be from a validated brucellosis free herd with the validation herd number and test date on certificate or be negative tested for brucellosis after June 8, 2009, and test date written on the certificate. Texas exhibitors must be from a validated brucellosis free herd with the validation herd number and test date on certificate or be negative tested for brucellosis after June 8, 2009, and test date written on the certificate.

B. Since all states are Stage 5 of the Pseudorabies (PRV) eradication program, no testing is required for this show. If the animals come from a Pseudorabies qualified herd, it is required that this number and the last test date appear on the health certificate.

C. Vaccination against Leptospirosis (6-way) including bratislava and erysipelas. The complete date of vaccination **MUST** be listed on the health certificate.

D. All health certificates must carry the following statements: no raw garbage fed, herd is not under quarantine for any disease condition and uses no PRV vaccine.

E. Since Utah requires a test for PRRS, no animal from this sale may be purchased to go to the state of Utah.

A health certificate must be inspected and approved by the Kentucky Department of Agriculture, Division of Animal Industry, before unloading. If you unload before the approval, you will be asked to leave.

Evidence that a paper has been altered will result in dismissal of the shipment. All swine brought to the STC must be listed on the health paper and meet the same requirements.

Any health certificate with animals originating from outside Kentucky **MUST** get a permit number before coming to the show. To obtain a permit number, a licensed, accredited veterinarian must call the Kentucky State Veterinarian's Office at 502.564.3956.

General Information

Entry fees for all entries must accompany the entry form and all late entries will be charged double the regular entry fees. The NSR reserves the right to close entries any time after the printed entry deadline. All entry fees are non-refundable. **Entries must be postmarked by May 15, 2009.**

Stress status of your entry will be placed in the show and sale catalog if known. (Not a show or sale requirement). A documented stress test must be presented at check in. All entries must

be earnotched using the official NSR system and weigh a minimum of 150 pounds. Entries will be divided into classes as equal as possible by weight.

Do not unload until your health papers have been approved by the health officials.

All hogs must arrive on the grounds between 8 a.m., June 30 and 9 a.m., July 2, 2009. No clipping is allowed in the barns.

Breeding Animal Sale

These animals will be selected by the judge with no set number selling from any single class. Exhibitors with animals not selected for the sale may consign their animals to the sale for an additional fee of \$20 per head. If the animal sells, the fee will be applied toward the sale commission. If the animal does not sell, the fee is forfeited.

All animals selected and cataloged for the sale must go through the auction. Sale commission will be 15 percent for all animals.

The NSR acts only as the agent between the buyer and seller. If proper payment is made by the buyer in a timely manner, the NSR will make settlement with the seller in approximately 30 days after the sale.

If an exhibitor has an NSR account that is past due, funds from the sale of their animals will be applied to their past-due account.

- Your driver's license number must be included on your health papers.
- Crossbred animals must have a federally recognized numbered tag.
- A premises ID number will be required to exhibit.
