

A Message from the NSR

To the Members and Stakeholders of the National Swine Registry,

It is our pleasure to present the following information as compiled in the annual report of the National Swine Registry, a partnership comprised of the American Yorkshire Club, Hampshire Swine Registry, United Duroc Swine Registry and the American Landrace Association. The Yorkshire, Hampshire, and Duroc associations each represent a 30 percent stake in the financial affairs of the NSR, while the Landrace are represented by 10 percent. Collectively, these four breeds represent more than 80 percent of the purebred hog registrations in the country and are incorporated into the breeding schemes utilized by commercial swine production throughout the world. The structure of the NSR is such that nearly all the income and expenses accrue to and flow through the organization.

2023 was certainly a year that presented challenges but great opportunities as well. Despite slightly lower sale totals, increased facility costs, and changes to and reductions in staff positions, the National Swine Registry was still able to achieve success. The organization was able to me continue virtual and online merchandising events. The Draft Virtual Sire Sale, in its fourth year, grossed the highest it ever has. The Collector's Edition Bred Female Sale was up from 2022. The Exposition sale was up year-over-year, with two record sellers. Additionally, online bidding services have been and will continue to be utilized to help members capture maximum value at NSR events. One assumption when drafting the 2017 Long Range Strategic Plan was selling fewer pigs for a higher average; this trend has continued as

well. International litter recording, reduced due to the inability to travel and promote our genetic program, are poised to rebound in early 2024.

NJSA continues to be the driver of much of our business, with youth swine projects driving demand for purebred genetics. The interest in swine exhibition has never been higher, and NSR governance has created new opportunities through programs like the Purebred-Influenced, Light, and Dark Crossbred Divisions at all NJSA events, new or reimagined shows and events, and expanded premium and award recognition. Additionally, the NSR Foundation, aided by the creation of numerous new scholarships, has a record number of funds available to help future leaders grow and develop through scholarship programs and leadership opportunities.

Despite all these exciting advancements, the driver of success for the registry continues to be the support and resiliency of our membership. We humbly invite you as members to study the status of the association carefully.

A heartfelt thank you goes out to each of our staff for your exceptional efforts and commitment to the NSR membership. Your work ethic, professional service, and resiliency does not go unnoticed. Additionally, thank you to our dedicated breed boards and executive committee members for your leadership and service to the largest swine breed registry in America.

Looking forward to continued success in 2024!

BY BREED




BY TYPE








