NSR FALL CLASSIC **RULES & REGULATIONS**

Oct. 23-26, 2019 :: Entry Deadline: SEPT. 18, 2019

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Entry fees for all entries must accompany the respective entry form.
- All entries must be postmarked by September 18, 2019.
- All late entries will be charged double the regular entry fees. All entry fees are non-refundable.
- The NSR reserves the right to close entries due to pen space limitations any time after the printed deadline.
- All senior exhibitors must be active members of the NSR or must pay the \$75 non-member exhibitor fee. An active senior member is age 22 and OVER, paid annual dues and recorded at least one litter in the 2019 fiscal year.
- Participants age 21 and UNDER are required to pay a \$15 junior participation fee.
- All pedigrees for purebred breeding animal entries must be recorded by October 9, 2019, or an additional rush fee will be charged.

EXHIBITOR REQUIREMENTS

- If an exhibitor has a NSR account that is past due, funds from the sale of their animals will be applied to their past-due account.

ANIMAL REQUIREMENTS

- All entries must be ear notched using the official NSR system (starting with number 1 in January and again in July of each year).
- No purebred entries will be eligible to show or sell without a registration certificate.
- Purebred breeding animals must have been farrowed on or after March 1, 2019.
- Purebred breeding animal classes will be divided as equally as possible by farrowing date.
- Crossbred boar classes will be divided by weight.
- CROSSBRED BOARS: A documented stress test must be presented at check-in. Stress status of boars will be listed in the show and sale catalog. This is not a requirement for crossbred gilts.
- Exhibitors transporting additional animals (deliveries/parking lot sales) will be required to obtain official "Sale Permit" from the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture staff when entering the Stephens County Expo and Fair.
- Before leaving the Stephens County Expo and Fair, this permit must be returned to agents of the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, with a detailed buyers list documenting the destination of each animal (including pre-purchased deliveries, parking lot sales and sifted weanling pigs).

DNA STRESS STATEMENT

- No known stress positive or stress carrier Duroc, Hampshire, Landrace or Yorkshire animals will be allowed to be exhibited or sold at any NSR-sponsored event.
- Such warranty is, however, solely that of the seller and not that of the American Landrace Association (ALA), American Yorkshire Club (AYC), Hampshire Swine Registry (HSR) or the United Duroc Swine Registry (UDSR).
- The ALA, AYC, HSR and UDSR assume no responsibility or liability in connection with such warranty by the seller.
- If any NSR purebred animal sold at this conference is found to be a carrier of the stress gene, the purchaser has the right to receive full refund of the purchase price from the seller.
- DNA testing for the stress gene must be done within 60 days of the sale date and all costs associated with testing for stress must be paid by the purchaser. The seller has the right to review the test results and the right to re-test the animal at a laboratory of his/her choice.
- Cost associated with re-test by the seller is at the seller's expense. There will be no refund of NSR commission from stress-carrier animals.

BREEDING ANIMAL SALE

- A minimum of 60% of the number of each sex (boars and gilts) shown will be selected for the sale. These animals will be selected with no set number selling from any single class. Animals not selected for the sale can be consigned to the sale for an additional fee of \$20 per head; this must be done by the conclusion of the show. If the animal sells, the fee will be applied toward the sale commission. If the animal does not sell, the fee is forfeited.
- All animals selected and cataloged for the sale MUST go through the auction. Sale commission will be 15% for all animals. If an animal that is selected and cataloged for sale does not go through the sale ring, the exhibitor will be banned from exhibiting at NSR events for one year and will be charged 15% of the average selling price of their respective breed sale. This amount must be paid before reinstatement will be allowed. The exception to this rule will be if an animal has become injured or ill and is inspected by an NSR staff member prior to the sale.
- The NSR acts only as the agent between buyer and seller. If proper payment is made by the buyer in a timely manner the NSR will make settlement with the seller in approximately 30 days after the sale.

PUREBRED BREED ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- By entering any purebred hog in the NSR Fall Classic, the owner warrants that the hog meets specific breed requirements.
- Such warranty, however, is solely that of the seller and not that of the ALA, AYC, HSR and UDSR and the ALA, AYC, HSR and UDSR assumes no responsibility or liability in connection with such warranty by the seller.

- If any Duroc, Hampshire, Landrace or Yorkshire animal sold at the NSR Fall Classic fails their respective breed DNA testing policy approved by the UDSR, ALA, AYC and HSR, the seller agrees that he/she will promptly refund the full purchase price to the buyer. There will be no refund of NSR commission from animals that fail their respective breed testing.

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HEALTH REGULATIONS – UPDATED!

ATTENTION: With heightened awareness and concerns with Foreign Animal Diseases (FADs), specifically African Swine Fever (ASF), it is critical to follow all health requirements below and that veterinarians and exhibitors take extra precaution to ensure the health of their animals. All animals attending the NSR Fall Classic should be inspected by an accredited veterinarian prior to an exhibitors' departure for the show.

If show staff or state officials identify animals that may have health concerns during unloading or while at the show, action may be taken, not limited to quarantine or sending animals home.

1. EACH ANIMAL ENTERING THE STEPHENS COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS MUST BE LISTED ON AN OFFICIAL INTERSTATE CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) ISSUED BY A LICENSED, ACCREDITED VETERINARIAN. **THIS INCLUDES DELIVERIES AND PARKING LOT PURCHASES.** LOADS CONTAINING ANY SWINE WITHOUT ALL THE BELOW MENTIONED REQUIREMENTS WILL NOT BE GRANTED ACCESS TO THE STEPHENS COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS.
 - A. All animals and CVI's will be inspected by state officials prior to unloading.
 - B. Multiple animals may be listed on the same original CVI. **However, breeding stock and weanling pigs must be entered individually on separate original CVI's.**
 - C. **All entries coming from outside of Oklahoma** MUST obtain an interstate permit number. Only your accredited veterinarian may obtain this permit number by calling the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture at 405.522.6141.
 - D. CVI's are not required to be stamped by the state of origin.
2. CVI's **MUST BE ISSUED ON OR AFTER WEDNESDAY, OCT. 9, 2019, WITH THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION**
 - A. Name and address of consignor; consigned to Fall Classic, Stephens County Expo and Fair, 2002 South 13th Street, Duncan, OK 73533.
 - B. **ALL animals (including deliveries and parking lot purchases) MUST be officially identified with a federally approved, permanently numbered ear tag.** For more information on federally approved ear tags, please visit http://www.nationalswine.com/shows/ear_tags.php. ***SWINE ORIGINATING FROM OKLAHOMA MUST HAVE AN OFFICIAL ELECTRONIC 840 TAG***
 - C. Ear notches and official identification of each animal MUST be listed on the CVI.
 - D. Health status of animal, including dates of required tests and vaccinations MUST be listed.
 - E. A premises ID number MUST be included on the CVI.
 - F. Your veterinarian's cell phone number MUST be included on the CVI.
 - G. ALL CVI's MUST CARRY THE FOLLOWING STATEMENTS:
"Farm or origin of the swine:
 - i. Has not had pseudorabies or swine dysentery in the last 12 months
 - ii. Has not had any clinical signs or diagnosis of TGE or PEDv in the last 60 days
 - iii. Feeds no raw garbage and uses no PRV vaccine
 - iv. Is not under quarantine for any disease condition
 - v. Has not had vesicular stomatitis diagnosed within 10 miles of farm or origin in the last 30 days
3. **REQUIRED TESTS:**
 - A. **PSEUDORABIES (PRV) TESTING:**
 - i. ALL ANIMALS MUST be individually tested for PRV **ON OR AFTER FRIDAY, SEPT. 27, 2019 UNLESS** animals come from a PRV-qualified herd.
 - a. Swine tested must have all official identification and also include sex, ear tag and ear notch along with date blood sample was drawn (month, day and year) and negative results listed on CVI.
 - b. Animals must test PRV-negative with all results on the dated CVI.
 - c. Either the ELISA (gB ELISA), ALA or S/N tests are acceptable. Differentiable ELISA (g1 ELISA) test will NOT be accepted.
 - d. If the herd of origin is PRV qualified, individual testing of each animal is not required. In this case, the PRV qualification number must appear on the CVI and the most recent quarterly herd test date (month, day and year) must be stated on the CVI. **The earliest quarterly test date that will be accepted will be July 27, 2019.**
 - B. **BRUCELLOSIS TESTING:**
 - i. ALL ANIMALS MUST be individually tested for brucellosis **ON OR AFTER FRIDAY, SEPT. 27, 2018 UNLESS** animals originate from a validated brucellosis free herd.
 - a. Swine tested must have all official identification and also include sex, ear tag and ear notch along with date blood sample was drawn (month, day and year) and negative results listed on CVI.
 - b. Animals must test brucellosis negative with all results on the dated CVI.
 - c. The RAP, Standard Plate, Standard Tube or BAPA brucellosis tests are all accepted.
 - d. If the herd of origin is brucellosis validated, individual testing of each animal is not required. In this case, the validation numbers must appear on the CVI and the most recent quarterly herd test date (month, day and year) must be stated on the CVI. **The earliest quarterly test date that will be accepted will be July 27, 2019.**

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4. VACCINATIONS:

- A. ALL animals being exhibited in the breeding shows MUST be vaccinated against Leptospirosis (6-way) including Bratislava and Erysipelas **ON OR AFTER SEPT. 27, 2019**. The complete date of vaccination MUST be listed on the CVI. **This is not a requirement for weanling pigs.**
- B. All **WEANLING** animals MUST be vaccinated against mycoplasma & circovirus. **This is a sale requirement for weanling pigs only.**
- C. It is strongly recommended that all animals are vaccinated against influenza. This is not a requirement.

5. PERMIT REQUIREMENT

- A. All **out-of-state entries** MUST obtain an interstate permit number. **ONLY** an accredited veterinarian may obtain this permit number by calling the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture at 405.522.6141.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- **We highly recommend printing these requirements and reviewing them with your veterinarian.**
- **Please review CVI's prior to leaving for the event to ensure all required information is completed accurately.**
- **Oklahoma Exhibitors: Some requirements listed above may be in addition to the health requirements for fall shows in Oklahoma. However, they must be included on the animals CVI's in order to be exhibited at the Fall Classic.**
- Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Veterinarians will inspect all animals and CVI's prior to unloading. Any animals not meeting health requirements may be prevented from exhibition at this event.
- In some instances, these rules are in addition to Oklahoma regulations, but are necessary to sell animals into other states to meet interstate transport and entry requirements for swine.
- The rules above are the same for breeding stock & weanling pigs unless specified otherwise.

Purebred boars and gilts must be farrowed on or after April 1, 2018. Ear notches, farrowing dates and entry fees for each animal must accompany the entry blank. Substitutions are allowed.
